The Scottsburg High School and Scottsburg Middle School Destination Imagination teams recently competed at the Indiana state DI competition. We are excited to announce that both teams placed near the top of their divisions and were invited to the Global competition at the University of Tennessee in Knoxville.

As you might expect, this is where you come in. The cost is \$750 per student and per coach. The SMS middle school has 9 team members (7 students, 2 coaches) and the SHS team has 6 members (5 students, 1 coach). With 15 team members the total cost to compete is \$11,250. This covers all expenses including food and lodging. Scott District 2 has been very generous in paying \$4750, which has covered all initial registration costs. This leaves \$6500 that the teams are working frantically to raise.

Any monetary donation would be greatly appreciated. Currently, our biggest enemy is time. All fees are due upon arrival, May 24^{th} , at the University of Tennessee. We sincerely apologize for the short notice. With only a month between State and Global competitions fund raising has been quite a challenge.
