Yesterday, Drug Free Communities Coordinator, Jamie Raichel, shared with the CEASe Coalition about plans to apply for the following funding:

### CARA Local Drug Crises Grants

\*\$50,000 per year for 3 years (no match required)

\*Only DFC communities are eligible to apply

\*Purpose: “Prevent and reduce the abuse of opioids or methamphetamines and the abuse of prescription medications among youth ages 12-18 in communities throughout the United States.”

\*DUE: January 29, 2018

She shared that in order for a community to prevent and reduce the negative impact of ACES (adverse childhood experiences), it must build resilience through Trauma-Informed Communities.
