Program: Don Cooper introduced Juanita Lowry, owner and operator of The Sunshine House on the Square in Scottsburg for her presentation. Juanita thanked the Kiwanis for inviting her and for all the support they give to the Scott County Community. She explained her first quest for better health began with the book "Fit for Life", by Marilyn and Harvey Diamond. In 1990 she was in a car accident that totaled her car and was able to recover with conventional and alternative care. The alternative care involved deep muscle therapeutic massage, chiropractic adjustment, bio-feedback, Reiki, Yoga and Tia Chi. Juanita and LL Lowry opened the Sunshine house Health Food Store in October of 1991. She has certifications in Iridology and Kinesiology from Trinity Health Practitioner's School. She has several certifications in Herbology from Nature's Sunshine and Miesee's Natural Health Center. Juanita belongs to the National Products Association and the Regional MAHO Association. She has attended conventions and seminars on health and wellness for several years. Juanita gave a few demonstrations of Shiatsu and Reiki and also gave reference to some of her favorite books: *Prescription for* Nutritional Healing, Little Herb Book Encyclopedia, and Eat 4 Your Type. The Sunshine House has held many seminars on health and wellness and hosted herb walks, etc. over the past few years. The Kiwanis thanked Juanita for her presentation and for providing this service to the community.
